**BAINBRIDGE ISLAND MUNICIPAL COURT TO BEGIN OFFERING PASSPORT SERVICES  
Passport Services Will Start July 5**

**Bainbridge Island, Wash.**, (June, 2017). The City of Bainbridge Island is pleased to announce that starting July 5, you will no longer need to leave the island to access passport services.

Beginning July 5, the Bainbridge Island Municipal Court will be able to process your passport applications. Passports will be available by appointment only, Wednesday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Appointments to receive passport services can be made online by visiting <http://www.bainbridgewa.gov/Passports>. The Municipal Court is accepting appointments now for dates starting Wednesday, July 5.

“We are very pleased to begin providing this service to the community,” stated Judge Sara McCulloch. “The staff at the Municipal Court look forward to assisting you with your passport application.”
