

ORDINANCE NO. 98-22

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington, amending the City's Comprehensive Plan to incorporate a new over-all goal and a new element, the Cultural Element.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a Comprehensive Plan on September 1, 1994, which has subsequently been amended; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Growth Management Act allows for the inclusion of additional elements to local comprehensive plans; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance 92-31 (BIMC2.42) designating the Arts and Humanities Council and requiring them to prepare a plan for the arts and humanities within the city which is consistent with, and may approved for inclusion in, the city's comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities Council developed and adopted the Cultural Plan in January of 1995; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN, as follows:

Section 1: The over-all goals of the comprehensive plan are amended by the addition of a new goal, as follows:

Support, protect and enhance the value of the arts and humanities as essential to education, quality of life, economic vitality, broadening of mind and spirit, and as treasure in trust for our descendants.

Section 2. The comprehensive plan is hereby amended by the adoption of a new element, the Cultural Element.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


