

# SANWICK ROAD NEIGHBORHOOD USE

## USES & AMENITIES:

Scenic view (Agate Pass), wildlife watching, kayaking.

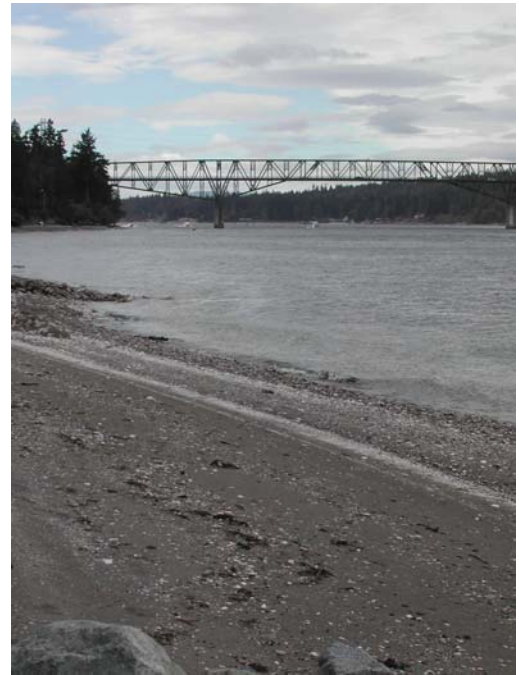


## SITE DESCRIPTION:

This road-end is a wonderful shoreline access point. A gently sloped gravel path provides access from the end of the paved road to the sand/gravel beach. Users should be aware that currents can be very strong in Agate Passage.

## BACKGROUND/ HISTORICAL INFORMATION:

Council approval as public road-end on 11/21/96. Site improved with a bench and trail by Boy Scouts.

## MAP & DIRECTIONS:

47°43.03'N 122°33.38'W

Refer to North Bainbridge Area map.

From Hwy 305, turn east on Agatewood Road. Road becomes Dolphin Drive as it makes a 90 degree turn to the right. Turn left onto Agate Pass Road. Turn left onto Sanwick Road and follow to end.
