USES & AMENITIES:

Scenic views (Olympic Mountains, ferry route, Rich Passage), wildlife watching, diving (underwater habitat), kayaking. Walk to Fort Ward State Park.

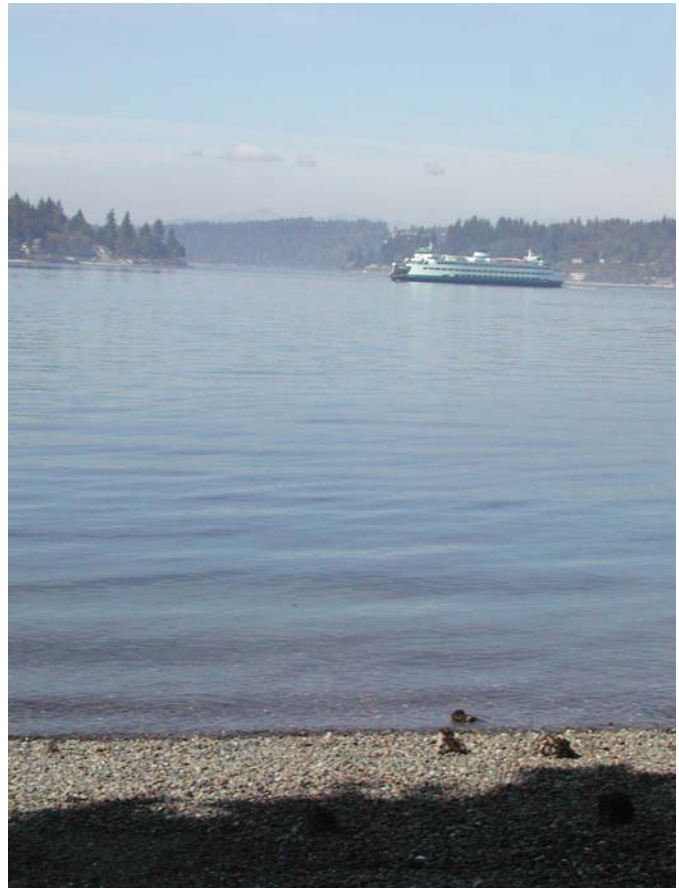


SITE DESCRIPTION:

This 40-foot wide right-of-way extends from Pleasant Beach Drive to Rich Passage. The beach is gently sloping, and sandy, with driftwood. This site has been greatly improved by a 1999 Boy Scout project. Access is easy to this no-bank beach.

BACKGROUND/ HISTORICAL INFORMATION:

Council approval as public road-end on 8/21/97. Historic site of Pleasant Beach Hotel, Steamer Dock (1880s-1930s). 1999 Boy Scout Project.



MAP & DIRECTIONS:

47°35.57'N 122°32.01'W

Refer to South Bainbridge Area map.

From Lynwood Center, drive south on Lynwood Center Road. Road becomes Pleasant Beach Drive. At 'Y' in road, veer right, continuing on Pleasant Beach Drive. Turn right on Wharf Street about ¼ mile before Fort Ward State Park.
