

CRYSTAL SPRINGS / POINT WHITE DRIVE

USES & AMENITIES:

Scenic views (Port Orchard, Rich Passage, Sinclair Inlet), wildlife watching, walking, biking.



SITE DESCRIPTION:

This three-mile stretch of shoreline road provides excellent views of Port Orchard and Rich Passage and is a popular walking and biking route. Use caution as shoulders are very narrow. Road passes by other shoreline access sites such as Point White Dock and Schel-Chelb Estuary.



BACKGROUND/ HISTORICAL INFORMATION:

Popular area for summer cottages with historic mosquito fleet ferry access to Bremerton from Point White Dock.

MAP & DIRECTIONS:

Refer to South Bainbridge Area map.

From Lynwood Center, turn west on Point White Drive, and follow along shoreline. Road becomes Crystal Springs Drive. Note that road is a dead-end north intersection with Baker Hill Road.

NEARBY SHORELINE ACCESS:

- Point White Dock (park)
- Schel-chelb Estuary (road-end)
- Lytle Road (road-end)



(several pullouts along the road shoulder, best parking at Point White Dock).
