

**ORDINANCE NO. 2007-09**

**AN ORDINANCE** of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington, relating to the police investigative fund; and amending Section 3.10.025 of Chapter 3.10 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 3.10.025 of Chapter 3.10 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:


**“3.10.025 Police investigative fund.**

In addition to the amounts shown and described in BIMC 3.10.020, there shall be maintained a police investigative fund in the amount of \$5000.00 under the control of the chief of police and subject to no less than the same controls described in this chapter for other portions of the city’s petty cash fund.”


**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
