Early Start for Manitou Beach Drive and North Madison Avenue Road Works

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, Jan. 28, 2011 – Public Works Director Lance Newkirk announced today that asphalt repair work on Manitou Beach Drive and construction of a paved shoulder for bicycle and pedestrian traffic along North Madison Avenue NE (between Highway 305 and Valley Road) will begin Mon, Jan. 31, 2011.

Newkirk added that the work was originally scheduled to begin Feb. 28, 2011, but given the unseasonably warm weather conditions, the general contractor (ACE Paving) and Public Works staff discussed and agreed to an earlier start date. Newkirk said, “The early start helps the department manage its resources better, as well as giving us the opportunity to provide the community with these improvements sooner.” Project completion is scheduled for spring 2011.

Traffic disruptions and limited duration road closures will be required during the project. Advance public notification will be provided.
