Winslow Way Road Closures & Traffic Revisions Begin March 21

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, March 15, 2011 – With major construction set to begin next week, road closures and traffic revisions in the downtown area will be in effect from 5 am on Monday, March 21, 2011. Winslow Way will be opened to westbound traffic only between Ericksen and Madison Avenues. The eastbound lane will be closed between Ericksen and Madison Avenues. The north leg of the Madison/Winslow intersection will also be closed. The closures are due to pulverizing asphalt work in preparation of underground utilities work.

It is anticipated that the north leg of the Madison/Winslow intersection will reopen after several weeks of construction. The eastbound lane will remain closed for the duration of the project and is scheduled for reopening in late June 2011, unless unforeseen circumstances arise.

Parking will be available on the south side of the roadway. Sidewalks throughout the entire work zone will primarily remain open; however, closures will periodically occur during the installation of utility connections.
