### **Williams Property Proposed for Transfer to Park District**

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, November 10, 2009 – The City of Bainbridge Island will hold a public hearing Monday, November 23, 2009 to consider whether to deem the Williams Property surplus to the needs of the city, and whether to transfer the property to the Bainbridge Island Metropolitan Park and Recreation District. The Williams Property, which is approximately 3.81 acres in size, is located on the Island's eastern shore north of Williams Lane and also includes a 5.21 acre tideland parcel. Acquisition of the property was arranged by the City's Open Space Commission, and it was intended at the time of purchase that the property would later be transferred to the Park District for stewardship. It is understood that upon transfer from the city, the Park District would maintain and utilize the Williams Property as a passive public park and/or open space.

The public hearing will be held Monday, November 23, 2009, as part of the regular City Council meeting, which begins at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall, 280 Madison Ave. North, Bainbridge Island, Washington.
