DESCRIPTION/SUMMARY
On October 10, 2007, the City Council authorized two grant agreements for habitat restoration projects at Strawberry Plant and Pritchard Parks. Council requested that staff bring back a resolution that would restate council policy that had been adopted by motion.

RECOMMENDED ACTION
Adopt resolution 2007-29.

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-29

A RESOLUTION by the City of Bainbridge Island City Council, Bainbridge Island, Washington, clarifying policy for design of habitat restoration projects at Strawberry Plant and Pritchard Parks.

WHEREAS, the City owns the Strawberry Plant property; and

WHEREAS, the City owns the Pritchard Park property jointly with the Bainbridge Island Metro Park and Recreation District; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and was awarded a Salmon Recovery Funding Board grant (Project #06-2300N) through the State Recreation and Conservation Office to design and construct a shoreline habitat restoration project along the east bluff of Pritchard Park that also provides a permanent fix for failing infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and was awarded a Salmon Recovery Funding Board grant (Project #06-2294R) through the State Recreation and Conservation Office to design a shoreline habitat restoration project at the Strawberry Plant property; and

WHEREAS, there are existing agreements, contracts, policies, and laws that affect the use of the Strawberry Plant and Pritchard Park properties; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2007 the City Council authorized the Mayor to sign the two Salmon Recovery Funding Board grant agreements for the projects at the Strawberry Plant and Pritchard Park properties and requested this resolution be prepared; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Through established cooperative efforts with the Bainbridge Island Metro Park and Recreation District, City staff will make its best efforts to prepare plans for habitat restoration and recreational use of the Strawberry Plant and Pritchard Park properties that maximize active and passive recreational uses to the greatest extent practicable consistent with the Bainbridge Island Comprehensive Plan and all applicable laws, contracts, agreements, and devices such as variances and exceptions.
